Dear PTHS Class of 2027:

It was only a few short months ago when I had the opportunity to meet many of you at the Four Years and Beyond Program as PTHS showcased what life as a student would be like as you enter high school. As the second marking period draws to a close, here at PTHS we have begun the scheduling process for next year. Tomorrow, January 26th, the PTHS guidance department will be visiting all Grade 8 Social Studies classes to review elective offerings that all incoming Grade 9 students will have the opportunity to take next year. Starting today, the Realtime Parent and Student Portal will be open for all Grade 8 students to begin to enter elective requests for next year.

PTHS has several resources that you can utilize to determine what electives are available as you prepare your child's course of study:

- 1) **Elective Website:** Our elective website has links to our current <u>Program of Studies</u> as well as all the Grade 9 elective offerings. Please click on the Grade 9 electives on the left side of the website: http://bit.ly/2MWwsph
- 2) Directions for Selecting Electives on Realtime: Click here to access directions to the Realtime Student/Parent Portal
 - a) It is very important that when selective elective requests that you make sure you prioritize your requests prior to finalizing them for submission. It is recommended that if your child would like Band or Choir for the 2023-2024 school year at PTHS, please make the course your #1 priority.

PTHS is requiring that all Grade 8 students please have their elective requests entered into the Realtime Portal by the end of the day on **Monday, January 30th.** In the near future, PV teachers will be making course recommendations for English, Math, Science, Social Studies and World Language. Once all recommendations are made, we will be sending out further instructions regarding our scheduling process. If your child is not planning on attending PTHS, please notify your child's guidance counselor. We do recommend that you enter in elective choices in the event that family plans change.
